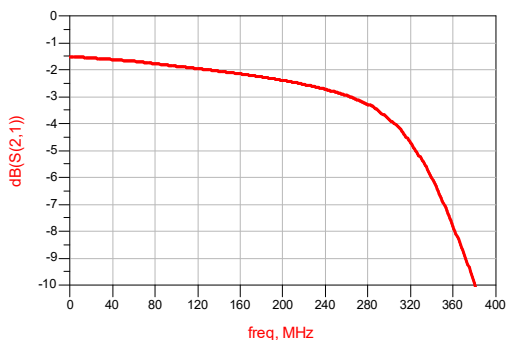

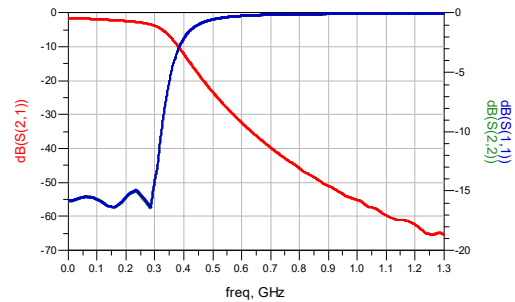
1. Dimensions are in millimeters. Tolerance: $\pm 0.05\text{mm}$
2. Die thickness is 0.1mm
3. Typical bond pad is $0.1 \times 0.1 \text{ mm}^2$.
4. The bottom of the device is gold plated, should be grounded.

Typical Test Curves

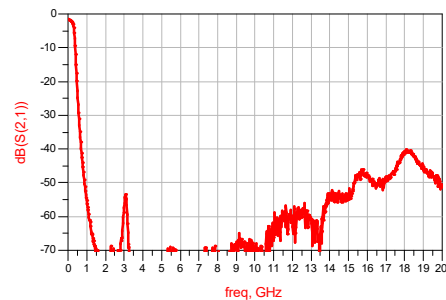
Insertion Loss VS Frequency ($T_A=25^\circ\text{C}$)



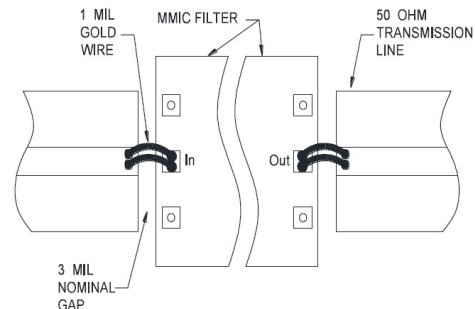
Insertion Loss & Return Loss VS Frequency ($T_A=25^\circ\text{C}$)

Recommended Assembly Diagrams



Application Notes:

1. The chip is back-metallized and can be die-mounted with AuSn eutectic preforms or with electrically conductive epoxy.
2. The die should be assembled on carriers like Kovar or Mu-Cu which have same Coefficient of thermal expansion. ($5.8 \times 10^{-6}/$) with GaAs.
3. Recommend using $\Phi 25\mu\text{m}$ Au wire for bonding, whose length is around $400\mu\text{m}$.
4. Sinter by AuSn (80/20), which doesn't exceed 300°C within 30 seconds max.
4. Handle the chips in a clean environment. DO NOT attempt to clean the chip using liquid cleaning systems.
5. Handle the chip along the edges with a vacuum collet or with a sharp pair of bent tweezers.
6. The device is sensitive to ESD. ESD protection is required during storage and usage.
