

#### Notes:


- 1. Dimensions are in millimeters. Tolerance: ±0.05mm

# **Typical Test Curves**


Insertion Loss VS Frequency ( $T_A=25^{\circ}C$ )




Insertion Loss & Return Loss VS Frequency (T<sub>A</sub>=25°C)

### **Recommended Assembly Diagrams**



### **Application Notes:**

- 1. The chip is back-metallized and can be die-mounted with AuSn eutectic preforms or with electrically conductive epoxy.
- 2. The die should be assembled on carriers like Kovar or Mu-Cu which have same Coefficient of thermal expansion. (5.8  $\times$  10-6/) with GaAs.
- 3. Recommend using  $\Phi 25 um$  Au wire for bonding, whose length is around 400 um.
- 4. Sinter by AuSn (80/20), which doesn't exceed 300°C within 30 seconds max.
- 4. Handle the chips in a clean environment. DO NOT attempt to clean the chip using liquid cleaning systems.
- 5. Handle the chip along the edges with a vacuum collet or with a sharp pair of bent tweezers.
- 6. The device is sensitive to ESD. ESD protection is required during storage and usage.
